ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the State of New Jersey is pleased to acknowledge the Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new Ashram of Bharat Sevashram Sangha of North America, New Jersey in Kendall Park, Middlesex County, on March 21, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, This significant event is the culmination of an extensive process of planning, organization, and preparation, which has been brought to fruition only through the extraordinary labors and efforts of a number of devoted people whose commitment to Bharat Sevashram Sangha is clearly evident; and,

WHEREAS, Bharat Sevashram Sangha is a traditional Hindu monastic organization established in 1917 by Acharya Swami Pranavanandaji Maharaj, and its New Jersey chapter was initiated twelve years ago; and,

WHEREAS, The new Ashram will house a five-thousand-square-foot temple, a community hall for cultural events, and rooms for yoga, meditation, and classes on Indian culture and heritage; and,

WHEREAS, It is altogether proper and fitting for this House to pause in its deliberations to recognize the Bhumi Puja of Bharat Sevashram Sangha, and to join in affirming the Ashram's important place in this State's religious community; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

That this House hereby honors Bharat Sevashram Sangha upon the occasion of its Bhumi Puja, and pays tribute to all those whose efforts have contributed to this praiseworthy endeavor; and,

Be It Further Resolved, That a duly authenticated copy of this resolution, signed by the Speaker and attested by the Clerk, be transmitted to Bharat Sevashram Sangha of North America, New Jersey.
