Bharat Sevashram Sangha in Kendall Park is ideally located on Route 27, and a few minutes from Princeton University. The Ashram building has out grown its current space. Recently overcrowding in class rooms and the demand for more programs has put a strain on the Ashram. In additions, we had to celebrate some of the religious festivals like Navratri/Durga Puja in out door tents in the cold months. Sometimes it rained which caused great inconvenience for all. Cars are usually parked on the lawn, many of you have experienced these difficulties.

4. **parking for 65 cars**
